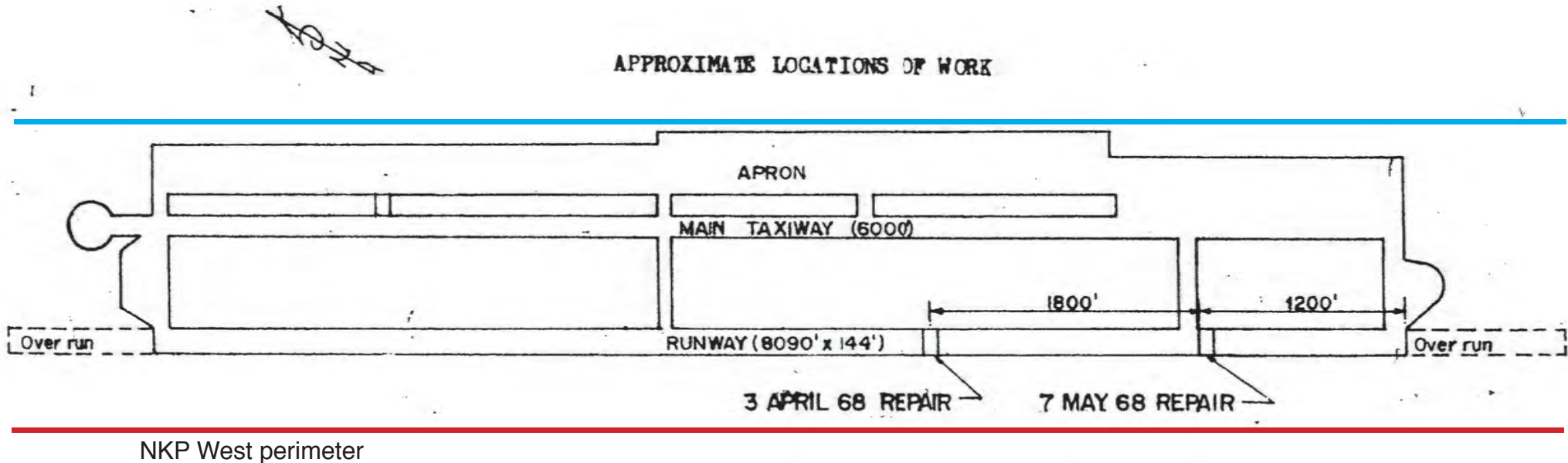


Nakhom Phanom RTAFB (NKP), Nakhom Phanom, Thailand, 1968

In 1968, NKP was Home to both U.S. Navy and U.S. Air Force Personnel. As to authorization to flightline and perimeter, the U.S. Navy Personnel is authorized by their NEC (Navy Enlisted Classification) and U.S. Air Force Personnel is authorized by their AFSC (Air Force Specialty Code). U.S. Army or U.S. Marine Corps Personnel who may have been TDY to NKP must be authorized to flightline and perimeter by their MOS (Military Occupational Specialty code).
